LNS Admissions Process

Welcome to LNS and thank you for your interest in our school.

We work hard to create a stimulating, challenging and nurturing environment to enable each student to achieve her full potential. Students are given opportunities to develop and learn new skills and are expected to make their own contribution to school life.

To achieve this we have developed a 2-part admissions system which does not simply look at the results of the entrance exam but also includes a face to face interview with the Head to see if there is potential for the student to develop in LNS and if she will ultimately be happy in our school environment. Last year we welcomed girls from Muslim and state primary schools.

The following diagram gives brief overview of our admissions process



After the interview parents will be informed of the outcome of their application by letter, conditional on receipt of written reports from the student's previous school. In order to secure their place a **non-refundable deposit of £1517.00** is payable.

We are selective in our intake of students to ensure that all new students contribute positively to the general ethos and vision of the school.

If students are placed on a waiting list parent/guardian will be informed of their position on the list. No priority shall be given to parents wishing to enrol their child after withdrawing from the waiting list, after refusing a place, or, having withdrawn their child partway through the academic year. In all of these cases the application will be treated as a new one, and so, the applicant will be placed at the end of the waiting list.

NB. Currently Lady Nafisa School is unable to cater for pupils with Special Educational Needs (SEN) and for whom English is an additional language (EAL). In the future, once we have provision and resources in place, we will consider all applications.
